Their days were filled with synod worship, interactive learning, accompaniment day, a scavenger hunt through the French Quarter and of course they made time to sample a few beignets!




### Cindy Pennie and her Mission group are in Tanzania.

#### Salem Invited to Provide Input on Bread for the World's Platform


