Koester. Jan 25 seems to be the logical choice to start the new course because many participants will be absent on Jan 4, we will have a Tanzania report/presentation on Jan 11, and Joanna and I will be travelling on Jan 18.



An overview of the new course states:

"Christians and non-Christians alike have been debating the message of the book of Revelation ever since it was first written. What are we to make of it? These 24 thought-provoking and enlightening lectures are your authoritative guide to this extraordinary work. In them, you'll explore the historical and intellectual background of the Apocalypse; enjoy a close reading of John's text, focusing on the meaning of its images; and consider the wide-ranging impact of the book on Christian and Western history."


